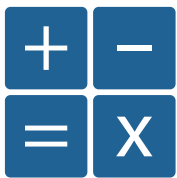

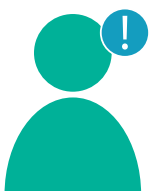

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We are excited to introduce INSIGHTS in Nebraska to your school!

INSIGHTS is an evidence-based emotional and behavioral skills intervention that has been found to reduce disruptive behavior, improve attention skills, and improve reading and math achievement. Developed in 2008 by New York University, researchers from the Nebraska Center for Research on Children, Youth, Families and Schools (CYFS) are receiving funding from the U.S. Department of Education's Institute of Education Sciences to study the program's efficacy in rural Nebraska schools.

INSIGHTS in Nebraska is a four-year project and will be available in 30 rural elementary schools in eastern and central Nebraska, with curriculum beginning January 2019.

Teacher and child curriculum occurs for 10 weeks during the spring of the kindergarten year and 10 weeks during the following first-grade year.

How does it work?

- The intervention is delivered to children once per week for 10 weeks in kindergarten and first-grade classrooms.
- Teachers use puppets to teach children that while certain situations may be easy for some individuals, they may be more challenging for others.
- The children engage the puppets in daily dilemmas to foster empathy and strengthen their problem-solving skills.

Comprehensive Approach

- Teacher, parent, and classroom programs work synergistically to support children's social-emotional development and academic learning.
- The intervention assists teachers and parents in recognizing how children's behavior is often related to their temperament/personality.
- Children also benefit from understanding that individuals respond differently to daily life situations due to their temperaments.

INSIGHTS in Nebraska consists of three programs:

INSIGHTS for Teachers

Training and coaching sessions help teachers to gain a better understanding of child temperament and how to integrate the curriculum in their classroom. They will also teach the INSIGHTS curriculum once per week with the help of a facilitator.

- 10 weekly 30-min. coaching sessions
- 10 weekly 30-min. curriculum teaching sessions

INSIGHTS for Parents

Parents learn about their child's temperament and how they can structure the home environment and their reactions to their child to help the child be successful.

- Six - 2.5-hour parenting sessions (kindergarten year)

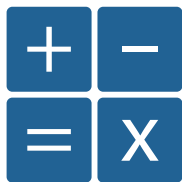
INSIGHTS for Children

Children engage the puppets in daily dilemmas to encourage empathy and strengthen their problem-solving skills. Teachers and facilitators help the children understand how one's temperament influences how they respond to different situations.

- 10 weekly 30-minute sessions in kindergarten; 10 weekly 30-minute sessions in first grade

Why INSIGHTS in Nebraska?

Children enrolled in INSIGHTS experience a significantly faster growth in math skills, reading skills and attention. They also saw a decrease in behavior problems.
